Fees

As discussed and voted on at BCRA AGM in 2016 road fees will remain the same for occupied lots at \$300.00. Also voted on by the membership was an increase for vacant lots of \$50.00 to \$200.00.

Collection

Please remember to pay your fees on time. You have a legal obligation as a home owner on a private road to pay for road maintenance. We have sought legal advice and discussed this issue many times with other private road associations as well.

As our residents in "good standing" percentage continues to increase, we still have a large amount of residents that are behind or choose to not pay. We all want a road to be proud of, and yes we have all had financial hardship at one time. It is not fair to increase fees on the road because some residents do not pay.

We would like to work with you this Fall. If you are behind or not sure of account status, we are happy to offer a payment plan (weekly, monthly etc.) to assist you in getting up to date. Of course we will keep all information confidential.

Beginning in Spring 2017 if we have not heard from you, we will begin to use an outside service for outstanding road fees. This <u>could</u> affect your credit rating. However, as long as we have spoken and have an agreement in place with you the homeowner, to bring your account up to date, no legal action or collection will take place. We are all volunteers and are trying to make this the best community we can. Please contact us today.



Internet

We are continuing to work with Lakeland Networks as we prepare for the installation of fiber-optic lines on Balsam Chutes Rd. I am in contact with Frasier often. At this point all the paperwork has been submitted to the road owner's lawyer's office. As soon as we have the approval Lakeland can begin installation this fall.

If the main line can be installed before winter, individual homeowners will be able to connect throughout the winter. I will post updates online and on Facebook as I get them. Cost will be around \$95.00/month which will include fastest internet in North America and home phone as well.

Speeding

Bridge Update

Stephenson Bridge has finally been removed. The crews are slightly behind schedule and the tentative completion date for the new ONE lane bridge is the end of October 2016.
