\*Fee Increase- As discussed and voted on at BCRA AGM in 2014 road fees will increase \$50.00 for 2016 to \$300.00 dollars for occupied lots, and increase to \$150.00 for vacant lots. Please pay your fees on time. This will allow your Board of Directors to plan for the 2016 road work campaign.
